Navigation system

Vehicle features and options

This chapter describes model-specific equipment, systems, and functions that are currently available, or may become available in the future, even if they are not present in your vehicle.

Overview

General information

The navigation system can determine the precise position of the vehicle with the aid of satellites, and guide you to every destination entered.

Certain functions of the navigation system are limited until they have been selected for data transfer. These services can be individually configured.

Safety information

\land Warning

Operating the integrated information systems and communication devices while driving can distract from surrounding traffic. It is possible to lose control of the vehicle. There is a risk of accident. Only use the systems or devices when the traffic situation allows. As warranted, stop and use the systems and devices while the vehicle is stationary.

\land Warning

There can be deviations between the current traffic situation and details of the navigation instructions, for instance changed road layout or road construction. There is a risk of accident. The respectively valid traffic rules take precedence.

Call up the navigation system

- 2. "NAV"

Via buttons

Depending on the vehicle equipment, the buttons on the center console or on the control display allow for fast access to the navigation system.

Map update

General information

Navigation data is stored in the vehicle and can be updated with a USB device or an automatic map update.

Current navigation data is available from an authorized service center or another qualified

service center or repair shop, or in the ConnectedDrive Store.

Depending on the data volume, the navigation data update may take several hours. The status of the update can be queried.

The navigation data is updated during the trip to preserve the vehicle battery.

Updating navigation data

- Connect the USB device with the new navigation data at a USB port capable of transferring data.
- 2. Follow the instructions on the Control Display.
- 3. Remove the USB device after the update.

The status of the map update is displayed during a navigation data update.

Automatic map update

General information

Depending on the vehicle equipment and national-market version, the navigation data for the home region is transmitted online to the vehicle several times a year and automatically installed and updated.

Cellular network reception is a prerequisite for the automatic map update.

Destination input

Vehicle features and options

Destination input by voice

General information

When making a destination input via the voice activation system, you can change between voice control and iDrive.

Say >Voice commands< or >Help< to have the available voice commands announced.

Say destination

- The desired destination can be spoken in one command or successively.
- For destinations in the same town/city, indicating the street is sufficient. The system will apply the current town/city automatically.
- You can search for points of interest using natural language, for instance by asking for restaurants nearby.
- The options available for entering data depend on the navigation data and the country and language settings.

Start guidance via voice



Press the button on the steering wheel briefly.

2. Say desired destination.

Guidance opens. If necessary, a confirmation is required.

Possible commands

- >Drive me to 300 Chestnut Ridge Road, Woodcliff Lake in New Jersey.
- >Drive me to the nearest parking lot.<
- > Take me home.<

Destination input

Principle

By entering a sequence of letters or numbers, you can search for destinations online or in the stored navigation data in the vehicle.

General information

The following information can be used for the destination input:

- Points of interest.
- Addresses.
- Contacts.
- ▷ Global Positioning System coordinates.

It is possible to search simultaneously by town/city and street. To do this, enter a text string for the town/city, then a blank space and a text string for the street name.

The search displays suggestions for which a search can be started without entering letters or numbers. Depending on the equipment, frequent search keywords are learned and included on the list of suggestions.

With a search for points of interest, the point of interest categories that were added as favorites and have been searched for most frequently are displayed.

Entering a destination

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Destination input"

A search box and entered information such as the search history are displayed.

- 3. Select the desired entry or the search box.
- 4. When selecting the search box, enter characters or choose one of the POI categories displayed.

If necessary, select **OK** to display more information, e.g. to preview a map.

Apply the suggested search keywords as necessary

- 5. Select the desired entry.
- 6. "Start guidance"

Recent destinations

General information

The previous destinations driven to are stored automatically.

Call up recent destinations

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Recent destinations"
- 3. Select desired destination.

Edit recent destinations

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Recent destinations"
- 3. Press and hold the desired menu item.
- 4. Select the desired setting.

My destinations

Principle

Depending on the vehicle equipment and national-market version, personal destinations are displayed.

General information

The following destinations are displayed:

- Received or future destinations
- Home and business address.
- Favorites.

Home and business address

General information

The home or business address must be specified to accept it as a destination.

Define home or business address

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "My destinations"
- 3. "Set address for "Home"" or "Set address for "Work""
- 4. Enter the address and possibly a name and further details.

Accept home or business address as destination

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "My destinations"

Editing home or business address

Favorites

Principle

Addresses, points of interest, and the current position can be stored as Favorites.

Storing current position as a Favorite

General information

The current position can be stored after entering a destination or via the map, even while driving.

Storing Favorites

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. Tap on the current position on the map.
- 3. "Save as favorite"

The current position is stored in the list of favorites.

Select favorite

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "My destinations"
- 3. Selecting an entry.

Edit favorite

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "My destinations"
- 3. Press and hold the desired menu item.
- 4. "Edit entry"
- 5. Select the desired setting.

Deleting Favorites

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "My destinations"
- 3. Press and hold the desired menu item.
- 4. "Delete entry"

Changing the sorting order

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "My destinations"
- 3. Press and hold the desired menu item.
- 4. "Re-sort list"

Received destinations

General information

Depending on the national-market version, the destinations are automatically stored as received destinations. The destinations can be transferred to the guidance if they were transferred to the vehicle via the BMW app.

Call up received destinations

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "My destinations"
- 3. "Future destinations"
- 4. If necessary, "Filter"
- 5. Select desired destination.

Points of interest

General information

Points of interest are destinations that can be helpful while driving. Points of interest such as filling stations, charging stations, restaurants or hotels can be accepted as destinations. Even when the navigation data is current, information regarding particular points of interest may have changed, e.g., certain filling stations or charging stations may not be operating.

Depending on the equipment, you can search for points of interest online or in the stored navigation data in the vehicle.

Online destinations/Information

General information

Depending on the national-market version, the results of a point of interest search are displayed with real-time data, e.g., fuel prices or availability of charging stations or parking garages.

Activating/deactivating online destinations

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Settings"
- 3. "Configure services"
- 4. "Online destinations"

Favored points of interest categories

General information

The points of interest categories that have been search for the most are displayed.

Select a favorite point of interest category to search for points of interest in the desired category at the current location.

Going to favorite point of interest categories

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Destination input"
- 3. Tap the search box.
- 4. The displayed point of interest categories are sorted by relevance.

Vehicles with charging socket: charging station display

Charging stations

Depending on the equipment and selected map mode, different icons are displayed for the charging stations:

- AC charging stations.
- DC charging stations, where AC charging may also be possible.
- Electric vehicles:

Quick charging stations with high charging capacity.

* Public BMW Charging stations, use with valid contract with the BMW Charging Card or the BMW Charging app.

Availability indicator of charging stations

Depending on the equipment, national-market version and available online data, a colored icon identifies the utilization of the charging station.

Color	Meaning
Green	Charging station is vacant.
Yellow	Several charging stations exist, partly occupied.
Red	Charging station occupied.

Even with the most up-to-date online data, the information on the utilization of the charging station may have changed.

Intermediate destinations

General information

An individual destination must be entered and the guidance must be started before entering an intermediate destination.

A maximum of 30 intermediate destinations can be entered.

Entering an intermediate destination

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. Select desired destination.
- 3. "Add as interm. destination"
- 4. If necessary, enter additional intermediate destinations.
- 5. "Start guidance"

Sort intermediate destinations

The order of the intermediate destinations can be adjusted. Starting from the second intermediate destination, the list of intermediate destinations will be displayed automatically after a new intermediate destination has been entered.

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Route overview"
- 3. "Sort destinations"
- Press and hold the desired intermediate destination and move it to the desired position.

Adjusting the intermediate destinations

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Route overview"

- 4. Select the desired setting.

Functions to destination

Immediately after making a destination input, additional destination functions are available.

- "Start guidance": start guidance to selected point of interest.
- "Add as stop": with active guidance, add a selected point of interest as an intermediate destination.
- "More information": go to more information for the point of interest, e.g., hours of operation.
- "Save as favorite": store selected point of interest as Favorite.
- "Nearby": go to other points of interest in the surrounding area.
- Phone number: dial stored phone number directly.

Status field

The following information is displayed:

- ▶ Icon for active destination guidance.
- ▶ Time and distance to destination.
- If necessary, time delay due to traffic obstructions.
- If necessary, suggest designations.

Traffic obstructions

When traffic bulletins are received, traffic obstructions can be displayed on the map.

Route

Principle

During the guidance, information about the current route can be displayed and the route details can be adjusted.

Route view

Depending on the equipment, different views are available to display the route details during destination guidance:

- Route preview as widget in the main menu on the control display.
- ▶ Map view.
- ▷ Route preview on the central display range of the instrument cluster.
- Depending on how the vehicle is equipped: route preview in the Head-up display.

Route calculation

General information

Depending on the equipment and nationalmarket version, routes are also transferred to the vehicle online. Information on traffic obstructions and traffic forecasts are taken into account for the calculation of online route suggestions.

For routes to be calculated online, the function must be activated in the Data Protection menu.

Activating/deactivating online route suggestions

Route preference

General information

The route calculated can be influenced by selecting certain criteria. The recommended route may differ from the route you would take based on personal experience.

Default settings

The route preference can be individually adjusted. The settings are stored as standard and automatically applied to new destination guidances.

Route magnet

Principle

With active destination guidance, the route displayed on the map can be adjusted manually. To do this, use a marker point, the so-called route magnet, to pull the route into the desired direction.

Open route magnet

Setting a route magnet

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Alternat. routes"
- 3. "Route magnet"

- Move the route magnet to the desired position.
- 5. Tap the route magnet to confirm the route magnet.

Editing a route magnet

- 2. Select the desired setting.

Route preview

Principle

When guidance is active, a route preview can be shown on the control display or on the central display range of the instrument cluster.

General information

Depending on the national-market version, the following information is displayed in the route preview:

- ▷ Guidance information, for instance, turn-off instructions or driving lane information.
- ▶ Notices, e.g., in case of dangerous curves.
- Display with different information. Displayed are, for instance, the name of the upcoming road, a tunnel or icons.
- Traffic events, for instance, traffic jams, accidents or construction sites.
- Additional information, for instance, tunnels or rest areas.
- > Distance to the next maneuver.

In the case of multi-lane roads, lane information may indicate the recommended lanes.

Depending on the equipment and nationalmarket version, the current vehicle position is displayed in the driving lane information.

Display

The information in the route preview is displayed, e.g., with the following icons:

Displaying the route preview on the control display

The route preview can be displayed on the control display as a widget in the main menu.

Alternative routes

Principle

When destination guidance is activated, if possible, alternative routes will be suggested.

As soon as alternative routes or detours are available, they will automatically be displayed on the control display and can be accepted in the guidance.

Displaying alternative routes manually

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Alternat. routes"
- 3. Select an alternative route or, if necessary, a recommended detour to accept it in the guidance.

Display

An overview showing the current route and the suggested alternative routes is displayed. The routes are displayed in color on the map.

The following details are displayed:

- Arrival time and, if applicable, information about the current traffic situation.
- ▶ Route length.
- ▶ Additional information, e.g., tolls.

Suggestions

Principle

If necessary, suggestions for the current route will be displayed automatically.

General information

Depending on the equipment, the available suggestions are highlighted in the toolbar of the map view.

The following suggestions, for example, are displayed:

- Possible places to stop, e.g., refueling or charging recommendations.
- ▶ Parking suggestions.
- ▶ Augmented View.

Going to suggestions

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Suggestions"
- 3. Select the desired setting.

Plan possible stops along the route

Principle

For the active destination guidance, a points of interest search can be used to plan possible stops along the route, e.g. to refuel, charge or to take a break.

General information

Map

With a low remaining range, a notification is automatically displayed with a refueling or charging suggestion. The refueling or charging recommendation shows a list of filling stations or charging stations, which can be applied as intermediate destinations.

Additionally, refueling or charging recommendations are displayed in the route preview.

Electric vehicles:

Information with charging recommendations is displayed immediately after you enter a destination, depending on vehicle equipment and national-market version. Alternatively, route guidance is started on a charging-optimized route with automatically selected charging stations. Charging recommendations or chargingoptimized routes are calculated when the destination entered cannot be reached with the current vehicle battery charge.

With the charging-optimized route, an optimum charge level is recommended for each charging station. This is the level at which the destination can be reached as quickly as possible. The corresponding expected charging time is given. The charging destination is optimized by the navigation system and changed for each charging stop added automatically. With a longer charging stop, the vehicle is charged beyond the optimized charging target.

- 3. Search for desired point of interest category.
- 4. "Filter results": adjust the search criteria as needed.
- 5. If necessary, "Show results"
- Select the desired point of interest. Details are displayed.
- 7. If necessary, "Start guidance"

Augmented View

Principle

Depending on the equipment, Augmented View provides support for upcoming maneuvers and parking at the destination.

General information

If there is an upcoming maneuver during route guidance, Augmented View is automatically displayed on the Control Display or central display range of the instrument cluster, depending on vehicle equipment.

Augmented View consists of a camera image of the actual vehicle's surroundings, displaying relevant information for the maneuver such as turn information.

Shortly before the destination is reached, information will be displayed that can be helpful for parking, e.g., parking suggestions.

Depending on vehicle equipment, Augmented View on the instrument cluster enables the visualization of driver assistance systems on the actual vehicle's surroundings.

Safety information

\land Warning

The system cannot serve as a substitute for the driver's personal judgment in assessing the traffic situation. Based on the limits of the system, it cannot independently react to all traffic situations. There is a risk of accident. Adjust driving style to traffic conditions. Watch the surrounding traffic situation closely, be ready to take over steering and braking at any time, and actively intervene where appropriate.

Sensors

Depending on the equipment version, the system is controlled by the following sensors:

- Camera behind the windshield.
- Front radar sensor.
- Radar sensors, side, front.
- ▶ Radar sensors, side, rear.

Alternatively, Augmented View can be closed with a button on the left of the display.

Displaying Augmented View manually

If Augmented View was closed manually for an active maneuver, the active maneuver can be displayed again.

Learning navigation

Principle

The navigation system learns when and which routes are typically used for certain locations. The most probable destinations can thereby be suggested for regular trips and driving time forecasts for the personal route can be taken into account.

Loading/deleting learned destinations

Suggested destinations

Destinations suggested by the navigation system can be dismissed. More information about the destination can be displayed.

- 1. Press and hold the suggested destination.
- 2. Select the desired setting.

Voice guidance

Principle

If destination guidance is active, voice guidance may be given for the respective maneuvers.

Activating/deactivating voice guidance

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. "Spoken instr."

Repeating voice guidance

Turn the voice guidance off and on again to repeat the voice guidance.

Volume

Turn the volume knob during voice guidance until the desired volume is set.

Map mode

Principle

Different views can be selected for the map to adjust the amount of displayed information on the map.

General information

Different map views can be helpful depending on the driving situation. The selected map mode determines the density of the displayed information, e.g., traffic bulletins, favorite points of interest or parking information.

Selecting the map mode

Depending on the equipment, different views can be selected.

- 1. "NAV"
- 2. 🕞 Select the icon.
- 3. Select the desired setting.

Reduced map mode

The displayed information on the map is reduced to the most necessary information. With active guidance, only information that is relevant for the current route will be displayed, such as traffic bulletins.

The display of traffic flow and traffic events is limited to the current route.

The green traffic flow for unrestricted driving is not displayed.

In this map mode, the manual zoom is available.

Adaptive map mode

The displayed information on the map is adjusted to the driver's handling and habits. Driving information for repeatedly driven routes or favorite points of interest can thereby also be displayed without active destination guidance.

If the home address, business address, or favorite destinations have been defined, more extensive information on the route can be displayed.



An Internet connection is required to transmit Amazon Fire TV content. The Personal eSIM is used to connect to the Internet.



- Bluetooth is switched on in the vehicle and on the device.
- Bluetooth presettings, such as visibility, may be required on the device; refer to the operating instructions of the device.

Registering a mobile device

Frequently Asked Questions

All prerequisites are met and all required steps were completed in the specified order. Despite that, the mobile device does not function as expected.

In this case, the following explanations can help:

Why could the device not be registered?

Too many other Bluetooth® devices are connected to the mobile device.

Delete the Bluetooth® connection from the device list of the device and start a new device search.

Too many Bluetooth® devices with the same function are registered.

Adapt the functions in the device list on the control display.

The device is in power economy mode or has only a low battery life.

Charge the device and deactivate the power economy mode if necessary.

Why is it no longer possible to operate the mobile device?

▷ The applications on the device do not function any more.

Turn the device off and on again.

▷ Too high or too low ambient temperature to operate the device.

Do not expose the device to extreme ambient conditions.

If all points listed have been checked and the required function is still not available: contact the hotline, an authorized service center or another qualified service center or repair shop.

Personal eSIM

Personal eSIM is a digital SIM card that is permanently installed in the vehicle.

Depending on the country of registration and the mobile phone provider, the digital SIM card may not available. In this case, a nano SIM card can be used with the BMW SIM reader in order to utilize Personal eSIM in the vehicle. The use of the vehicle cell phone antenna improves the call quality and the reception of mobile data. Additional information:

The SIM reader battery cover can be removed, for instance to insert a SIM card.

To close:

Inserting the SIM card

The SIM card slot is located under the battery cover on the underside of the SIM reader. To insert the SIM card, open the SIM reader.

- Insert the SIM card, with its contact surface facing down, into the slot until the SIM card engages.



3. Close the battery cover.

After the SIM card has been inserted, the SIM reader is ready for use.

Registering the SIM reader to the vehicle

The SIM reader must be registered to the vehicle once. The SIM reader can only be regis-

tered when the vehicle is stationary and the SIM card is inserted.

Resetting deletes all vehicles stored in the SIM reader and restores to the factory settings.

The current status of the SIM reader can be checked by pressing the connect button. The status LED lights up in the corresponding color.

Replacing the battery

🛆 Warning

Batteries or button cell batteries for batteryoperated devices can be swallowed, which leads to serious or fatal injuries within two hours, for example, due to internal burns or chemical burns. There is a risk of injury or danger to life. Keep batteries, button cells, and battery-operated devices out of reach of children. Up to ten devices can be connected to the personal hotspot simultaneously. If another device is to be registered, a device that is already registered must be deleted.

Functional requirements

- Standby state is switched on.
- Compatible device with activated WLAN interface.
- Personal eSIM is set up and active.
- The mobile data setting for the personal eSIM has been activated.
- ▶ WLAN is activated on the vehicle.

Activating the personal hotspot and registering the device

- 1. "MENU"
- 2. "All apps"
- 3. "Personal Hotspot"
- 4. "Connect new device"
- 5. "Activate internet access"
- 6. Register the desired mobile device on the personal hotspot:
 - Scan the QR code shown in the control display.
 - Enter the displayed access data on the mobile end device.

All devices connected via the hotspot use the data volume of the Personal eSIM.

The mobile device is displayed in the device list.

Connecting mobile devices

A connected USB device will be supplied with charge current via the USB port if the device supports this. Follow the maximum charge current of the USB port.

Frequently Asked Questions

All prerequisites are met and all required steps were completed in the specified order. Despite that, the mobile device does not function as expected.

In this case, the following explanations can help:

Why can telephone functions not be used via iDrive?

Phone functions are not configured for the mobile phone.

Connect the mobile phone with the telephone function.

Why are no or not all telephone book entries displayed or why are they incomplete?

- ▷ Transmission of the telephone book entries is not yet complete.
- It is possible that only the telephone book entries of the mobile phone or the SIM card are transmitted.
- It may not be possible to display telephone book entries with special characters.
- It may not be possible to transmit contacts from social networks.
- ▷ The number of phone book entries to be transmitted is too high.
- Data volume of the contact too large, for instance due to stored information such as memos.

Reduce the data volume of the contact.

- 3. Select entry to delete.

To delete multiple messages:

- 1. Select the desired message filter.
- 2. Press and hold the corresponding message.
- 3. Confirm the deletion.

All messages of the selected filter will be deleted.

Messages from the manufacturer of the vehicle with technical information or important customer information cannot be deleted.

Messages from other sources can be deleted.

BMW Assistance

Principle

BMW Assist includes various services having to do with the vehicle, e.g., customer support. The services help maintain mobility.

When starting the app, a one-time registration is required provided no ConnectedDrive account with a BMW ID has been created yet.

The vehicle must be linked to the BMW ID in order to use the functions; you only need to do this once. The link is established with the app. Confirmation in the vehicle via iDrive is also required.

Some functions, e.g., BMW Remote Services, enable communication with the vehicle without the need for you to be inside or at the vehicle.

Third-party apps
